



Admittance to 50p Cinema

We may ask for photographic identification (for example driving licence, passport or any other photographic identification that we deem to be acceptable) prior to permitting entry into 12A, 15 and 18 certificated films. We reserve the right to refuse entry if unable to provide identification.

- a) Children under 12 years of age are permitted to view films with either a U, PG, 12 or 12A certificate, provided always that:
 - i) children under 8 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times to watch any film;
 - ii) * children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult to watch any film with a 12A certificate; and
 - iii) children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult to watch any films starting at 7pm or later.
- b) *Other than as set out in (a), parent(s) and/or guardian(s) shall have sole discretion as to whether or not their children are accompanied.
- c) Parents and guardians shall at all times remain responsible for their child(ren) whether or not they are accompanied. Where a child is under 18 years old, in case of emergency, we would like to take contact details of a parent or guardian. This information will only be used for this purpose.
- d) For the purpose of the conditions of entry set out here, an adult is a person aged 18 years or over.



Parent and Guardian Contact Details Form

It is important for the parent or guardian to understand that we are not taking responsibility for their child and that as set out in paragraph (c) that parents or guardians are responsible for their child whether in attendance or not. This only needs to be completed where parents or guardians choose to drop children off or allow them to attend the cinema without them attending. This is in case an emergency arises.
